

Cascade Style Sheets (CSS)

1. Paragraph CSS (or Inline Styles)

```
<p style="color: blue; font-size: 12pt">This is blue text in a paragraph</P>  
<div style="color: green; font-size: 16pt">This is green text in a division</div>
```

2. Page Definition CSS (or Embedded Style Sheet)

```
<head>  
  <style type="text/css">  
    <!--  
      h1 {font: 28pt; font-family: "arial black"; color: green}  
      h2, h3 {font: 12pt; color: blue}  
    -->  
  </style>  
</head>
```

3. External CSS (or Linked Style Sheets)

Create External text file (C:\Stylesheet.css)

```
/* This is a comment */  
H1 {font: 28pt; font-family: "arial black"; color: green; text-align: center}  
H2, H3 {color: red; font-family: sans-serif}  
A:link { color: red}  
A:active { color: blue; font-size: 125%}  
A:visited { color: green; font-size: 85%}  
Table { background: #0c0 url(c:\Graphic.gif) no-repeat bottom right}  
Body { background-color: cornsilk}
```

Add code to each web page (To point to C:\Stylesheet.css)

```
<head>  
  <link rel=stylesheet  
    href=C:\Stylesheet.css  
    type="text/css">  
</head>
```

4. Class Selectors DIV tag

Open c:\stylesheet.css in a text editor

Add the following

```
.label { color: Red; font-size: 14pt; }
```

Save the c:\stylesheet.css

Open your HTML document in a text editor

Add the following to your HTML code

```
<div class="label">  
  This is my label  
</div>
```

5. Class Selectors SPAN tag

Another option is to use the Span tag. This can be used to span in the middle of a text string similar to using the font tag.

```
This is my <span class="label">example of using span </span>label.
```

6. Browser Tips

Internet Explorer Options: Tools→Internet Options→Accessibility→X Format documents using style sheets→C:\Stylesheet.css
